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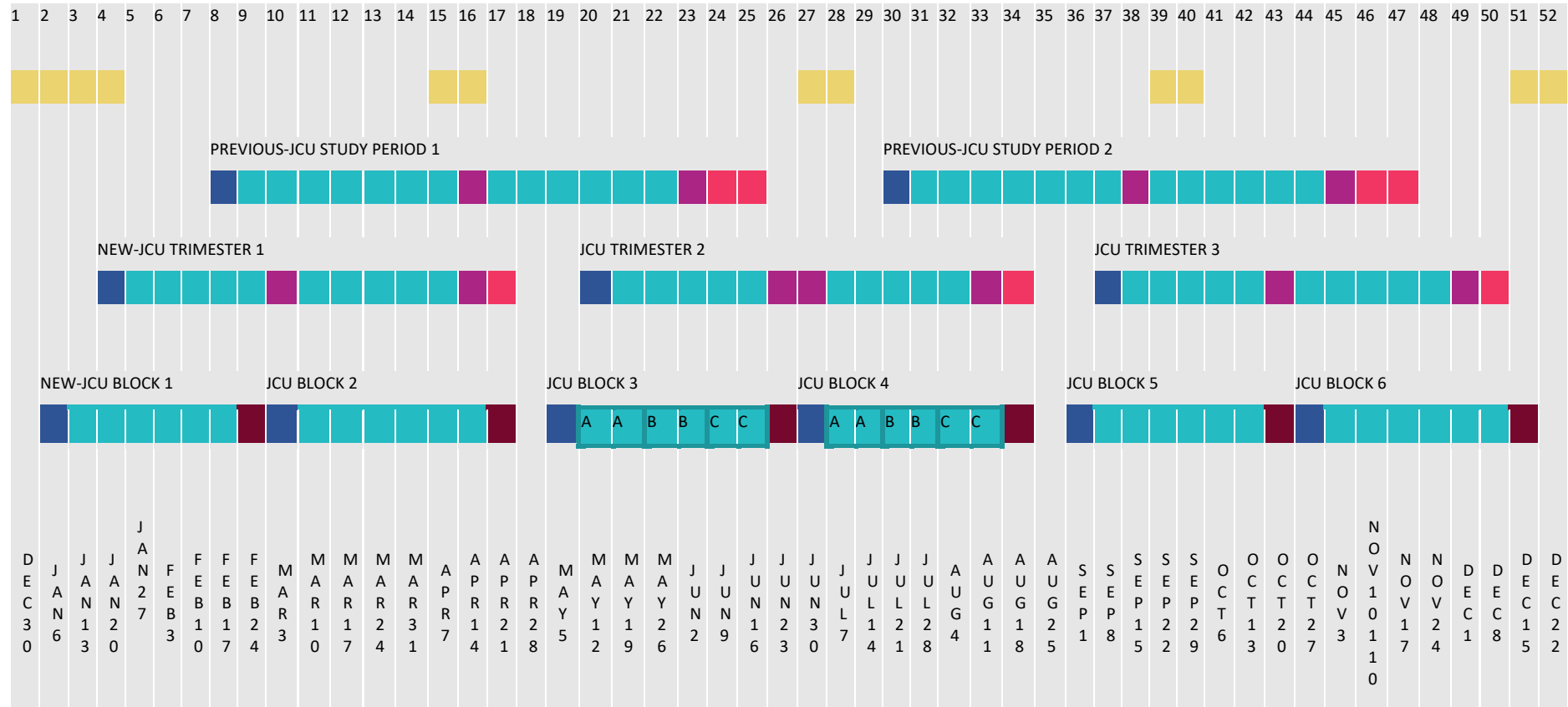

### Research Projects and Work-Integrated Learning (2025)

#### 3003: Science Research Internship-UG

requisites: GPA of 5.5/7.0 or equivalent

This subject is designed for students who are passionate about exploring the possibility of a research career in science and want to try their hand at research in a low-risk setting by undertaking a small scale (100 hour) independent research project. In consultation with staff, students will partake in existing research projects or co-design projects. Students will have an opportunity to develop research skills and contribute new insights into an area of personal academic interest. The subject is pass/fail and the main assessment consists of a scientific report and research presentation. To request enrolment in this subject students should (1) attain written approval from a research supervisor (usually an academic or research staff member in the college), (2) identify a project in consultation with the supervisor, and (3) then email that supervisor confirmation and a brief description of the project and study period to the JCU Placements team who will approve your enrolment into the subject.



#### 3008: Professional Placement -UG

requisites: STUDENTS MUST HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED 12 SECOND YEAR CREDIT POINTS. ENROLMENT IS RESTRICTED TO STUDENTS WITH AN APPROVED PLACEMENT.

This is the Work Integrated Learning subject for multiple undergraduate science degrees in the final year of study. The subject is designed to integrate knowledge and skills developed throughout the degree in a practical workplace setting. Students undertake a professional placement in a relevant, approved industry workplace or via an industry relevant project (minimum 100 hours). Students may source their own professional placements to meet their career goals or apply for a sourced placement. Through a number of tasks students will reflect upon personal and professional growth and evaluate the theory/practice nexus. Enrolment is restricted to students with an approved placement.
